The Lis Neris winery and Vineyards are located in the Village of San Lorenzo with Slovenia to the North and the Isonzo River to the South. The vineyards are planted in a unique area that thrives from its position located on a small plateau of calcareous gravel in close proximity to the Eastern Alps and the Adriatic sea to the South. Today, the Pecorari family, led by Alvaro, has immersed as one of Friuli's leading producers.

Grape Varieties:	95% Verduzzo and 5% Riesling
Location of Vineyards:	San Lorenzo
Vineyards:	Gris. The soil is calcareous and gravelly.
Vinification:	Harvested by hand, the grapes are dried up for 120 days in an air conditioned area. Fermentation takes place slowly in new French oak barrels. Wine is bottles 11 months after harvest.
Vines per hectare:	5,200 plants per hectare
Average age of vines:	30 year vines
Winemaker:	Alvaro Pecorari
Production:	2,000 .375 liter bottles
