The Tenuta Garetto Estate is a short ride from Asti in the municipality of Agliano in the region of Piemonte and is comprised of 18 hectares, mostly planted with South and Southwest-facing vineyards. Today the winery is run by the young Alessandro Garetto who has an extreme passion for Barbera which he plants at high density and uses vines up to 70 years old.
