His Testamatta Estate is located just above Florence and near Fiesole in the hamlet of Vincigliata where he resides in the Castello di Vincigliata. His wines are a true expression of Tuscany, since he refuses to grow international varieties and focus exclusively on Sangiovese, Canaiolo and Colorino. The charismatic Bibi is also a gifted artist and is part of a family of artists and sculptors. His wine labels are all masterpieces that he himself has painted.
